

## Pet Policy

## THE STANDARD PET POLICY

- 1. Animals should not be unattended on patios or balconies
- 2. Tenant is responsible for immediately cleaning up any animal defecation and animal defecation must be dealt with as follows:
  - Cats- inside the litter box only.
  - Dogs- outside, around the perimeter of the apartment property or in designated animal walks only. Tenant must immediately remove.
  - Failure to clean up after your pet will result in a \$50.00 violation fee, \$100.00 for second offense.
- 3. Animals must not disturb neighbors or others in and around the apartment community, whether the animals are inside or outside the Premises.
- 4. Animals must not be tied to any fixed object anywhere outside the Premises.
- 5. Animals, other than service animals, must not be let into swimming pool areas, offices, club rooms, or courtyards/common areas.
- 6. Animals must not be fed or watered outside the Premises.
- 7. No more than two pets per unit are permitted.
- 8. Cats must be neutered.
- 9. Animals shall be kept on a leash and under the Tenant's supervision and control when outside of the Premises. Failure to leash your pet may result in a pet violation fine of \$25.00.
  - The Landlord or Landlord's representative has the right to pick up unleashed animals or report them to the proper authorities.
- 10. Visiting animals, other than service animals, are not allowed.
  - Pets must be registered with the leasing office PRIOR to coming onto the property. Roommate consent is required prior to any arriving pets.

    Unregistered pets may result in a \$100.00 violation fee.

## PETS PROHIBITED

- Animals weighing over 50 lbs.
- Aggressive breeds: Chow, German Shepard, Doberman pinscher, Pit Bull Terrier, Rottweiler, etc.
- Exotic animals: exotic birds, snakes, ferrets, etc
